Tips to get ready for any weather.

Tē mōhiotia āhea ka pā mai ngā matepā māori, engari mā te takatū e tiaki ai koe i tō kāinga me tō whānau. Mā tēnei aratohu e whakaheke ngā mōrearea, e haumaruru ai hoki koutou ko ō piritata.

Natural hazards can happen anytime, but with a bit of preparation, you can protect your home and whānau. This guide will help reduce risks and keep you and your loved ones safe.



Ngā tohutohu e takatū ai

I mua i tētahi aituā

- Tirohia tō tuanui, whakawāteahia ngā kōhao me ngā pūwaha wai, topea ngā rākau, ā, āraia ngā kūaha me ngā matapihi.
- Whakaitahia ngā taonga kei waho, kawea rānei ki roto mēnā ka tae atu te wai ki tō kāinga. Me hiki ngā taonga whai wāriu me ngā rawa whare ki runga ake o te papa mehemea e taea ana te pērā.
- Whakaitahia ngā taonga mātangatanga pēnei i ngā ipu, ngā rawa whare, ngā tūraparapa, me ngā ipu tipu.
- Waihangatia tētahi mahere haumaruru āwhānau me tētahi wāhi haumaruru mō ngā mōreareatanga ahi taiao. Tipia ngā pātiti, whakatōkia he tipu ātete ahi, ā, whakawāteahia ngā otaota mura.
- Mō ngā rū whenua, whakahekea ngā taonga taumaha, kopī anō hoki, whakaitahia ngā rawa whare nunui, whakarawahia ngā kāpata, ā, kia mōhio hoki me pēhea te whakaweto i te haurehu me te wai.
- Whakaritea tētahi kete ohotata me tētahi mahere whakarere.

I te wā o te aituā

- Whāia ngā tohutohu a Te Rākau Whakamaruru me ngā ratonga ohotata.
- Mēnā e haumaruru ana, ā, kei te wātea te wā, whakawetohia te hiko, te haurehu me te wai.
- Noho ki roto, engari mēnā kāore e haumaruru ana, rapua tētahi whakaruru tata. Kaua e puta koronga-kore ki waho.

I muri i te aituā

- Hoki anō ki tō kāinga mēnā kua mōhio kei te haumaruru.
- Whakamahia ngā taputapu tiaki, ā, tuhia ngā pakarutanga.
- Waea atu ki tō kamupene inihua i mua i te mahi whakatikatika nonoi-kore.
- Whakaahua i ngā taonga i mua i te tuku ki waho, ā, me whai kia whakamaroke i ngā taputapu ka taea te tiaki.

Tips to get prepared

Before an event

- Check your roof, clear gutters and downpipes, prune trees and seal doors and windows.
- Secure outdoor items or bring them inside if flood water can reach your home. Move valuables and furniture off the floor where possible.
- Secure loose items like bins, furniture, trampolines, and pot plants.
- Create a family safety plan and a safety zone around your home for wildfire risk. Keep lawns short, plant fire-resistant vegetation, and clear flammable debris.
- For earthquakes, place heavy and fragile items low, secure large furniture, latch cupboards and ensure you know how to turn off your gas and water.
- Prepare an emergency kit and devise an evacuation plan.

During an event

- Follow instructions from Civil Defence and emergency services.
- If safe and time allows, turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Stay inside unless unsafe, then seek shelter nearby. Avoid unnecessary travel.

After an event

- Return home only when it is safe.
- Wear protective gear and document damage.
- Contact your insurer before making non-urgent repairs.
- Photograph items before disposal and try to dry salvageable items.

- ✓ Whakaurua ēnei tūraru ki ō whakatau mō te wāhi noho.

- ✓ Whai mōhio, whai wāhi hoki ki ngā kaupapa whakahaere matepā māori a tō kaunihera.
- ✓ Whakawhanaunga tahi ki ō kiritata me ngā rōpū ā-hapori kia whai tautoko ai i ngā wā o te ohotata
- ✓ Mahia ngā mahi hei whakaiti i te pānga o ngā matepā ki tō kāinga, ā, kia takatū mō ngā aituā.

Rārangi Kete Ohotata

- I tētahi ohotata, mehemea me wehe wawe koe i tō kāinga, whakaritea ēnei taonga, ā, puritia ki tētahi wāhi maroke, e māmā ai te tae atu:
- ✓ Tīpae rongoā.
 - ✓ Wai me ngā paramanawa (me mahara ki ngā rawa mā ngā pēpi me ngā mōkai).
 - ✓ Hū hīkoi, kākahu mahana, koti ua, me te pōtae.
 - ✓ Rama me ngā pūhiko.
 - ✓ Pūhiko whakauru mō tō waea me ētahi atu taputapu.
 - ✓ Reo irirangi (he hiko kōmaru, he hiko pāpāho rānei).
 - ✓ Tāruatanga o ngā tuhinga hira (matihiko, tuhinga rānei).
 - ✓ Patuero.

Emergency kit checklist

- In an emergency, you may need to leave home quickly, so prepare the following items and keep them in a dry, accessible place:
- ✓ First aid kit and medicines.
 - ✓ Water and snacks (remember supplies for babies and pets).
 - ✓ Walking shoes, warm clothes, raincoat and hat.
 - ✓ Torches and batteries.
 - ✓ Chargers for your phone and other devices.
 - ✓ Radio (solar, wind up or battery powered).
 - ✓ Copies of important documents (digital or paper).
 - ✓ Hand sanitiser.
